A Fisheries Technician II is responsible for a variety of semi-technical and semi-skilled tasks relating to fisheries management. Duties include but are not limited to, acclimation of juvenile coho, cleaning and maintaining fish raceways, stream snorkeling, trapping and transport of adult coho, spawning broodstock, cleaning and maintaining fish traps, operating and maintaining field equipment, operating a rotary-smolt trap, spawning ground surveys and biological sampling. Fisheries Technician II must be able and willing to work independently on occasion. Must be available to work weekends, night and holidays.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Some knowledge of standard fisheries principles and procedures.
- Able to express ideas effectively both orally and in writing.
- Able to work outside under all types of weather conditions and to perform physical labor.
- Work to assigned schedule, which may include weekends, nights and holidays.
- Able to report to work at a moment's notice, if and when need arises.
- Some knowledge and skill in the operation of equipment and tools, used in fisheries field of work.
- Able to acquire a commercial driver's license (CDL) with a tank endorsement.
