A Fisheries Technician II is responsible for a variety of semi-technical semi-skilled tasks relating to fisheries management. Duties include harvest monitoring stream surveys, marking fish, fish tagging and enumeration, environmental monitoring and recording field data. Fisheries Technician may operate independently occasionally.

- Some knowledge of standard fisheries principles and procedures.
- Some knowledge and skill in the operation of equipment and tools used in fisheries work.
- Ability to take some leadership responsibility.
