Position functions in the Yakama Agency Forestry Branch Fire Pre-suppression and Suppression Program. Incumbent is responsible for observing, locating and reporting forest fire and hazardous weather conditions in remote forest areas located on the Yakama Indian Reservation. The position requires a thorough knowledge of entire reservation geography and topography, road system, location of timber sale activities and various facilities such as dumps, mills, isolated residences in the protection area, etc. Work involves constant surveillance of the surrounding forest lands for unusual occurrences and/or emergencies and reports them accordingly to the Fire Dispatcher by radio. Incumbent also reports and records weather data on a daily basis, maintains activity log books and the upkeep of the lookout towers. Employee must be reliable and work independently, because of the emergency nature of the fire suppression program and because they meet time schedules independently, because of the emergency nature of the fire suppression program and because they meet time schedules independently. In addition, employee is subject to adjusted work weeks, irregular hours due to emergency situations and working holidays.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to see distant objects and distinguish shades of color.
- Ability to live alone in a relatively remote area.
- Ability to read and understand maps and road systems of the Yakama Indian Reservation.
- Ability to communicate by two-way radio.
- Ability to perform and communicate during emergency situations.
- Ability to understand radio messages and relay messages clearly.
- Ability to speak in a clear, concise, well-modulated voice.
- Ability to operate the equipment associated with the work of the class.

General Recruiting Indicators:

- Any experience or education which would demonstrate the ability to perform the work.
- Must be able to climb/work in towers 90 feet in height.
- For safety purposes children will not be able to accompany/reside with employee at the facility.
- Enrolled Yakamas will have preference in hiring.

Necessary Special Requirements:

- Possession of a valid /clear WA State Driver's license in order to operate tribally insured, government owned-leased vehicles.
- Must obtain & submit with application a current driving abstract for the past 5 years.
- Ability to pass a pre-employment Drug and Alcohol test.
