Provide support to the Hatchery Manager in the operation and maintenance of fish hatcheries; direct and monitor the work of subordinates and staff involved in all phases of the hatchery operation in order to achieve management goals.

- Knowledge of methods, techniques, tools and equipment used in fish culture
- Knowledge of and familiarity with experimental fish culture concepts, approaches, and programs

- Knowledge of care and propagation of fish and fish eggs
- Understanding of the nutritional requirements of anadromous fishes, including fish feeds, and feeding regimes
