Is responsible to utilize knowledge and expertise in the distance running program for high school and junior high school athletes. The coach is required to design and implement practice sessions, monitor athletes' fitness and promote team unity. The coach is responsible to utilize knowledge and experience in implementing training methods, stretching, pacing, meet scoring, and nutrition. The coach will promote and require academic eligibility for participation in the sport. Is responsible to exhibit a professional attitude and appearance as necessary in an educational setting. Transports team members as needed and will maintain transportation records. Maintains inventory records of equipment and uniforms. Maintains records of student participation and equipment assigned. The Yakama Nation Tribal School is a member of the Washington Interscholastic Activities Association.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to assume responsibilities in an educational environment working with students, their families and colleagues.
- Ability to communicate effectively with students, parents/guardians, supervisors and colleagues.
- Knowledge of the safety regulations, rules and policies that govern the cross country sport.
- Knowledge of equipment utilized in the program and ability to maintain it.
- Knowledge of physical fitness and proper diet regime required of young athletes to safely participate in any given sport.
- Ability to prepare a curriculum for the sport activity.

- Bachelor's Degree in Education, Health or related field preferred and demonstrated experience working with tribal youth. OR
- Any combination of related college courses, training and experience that provides ability to perform the responsibilities of this position.
- Must pass a criminal background check.
- First-aid certification preferred or ability to obtain a first-aid card during employment.
- Must possess a valid Washington State driver's license with ability to obtain a tribal permit.
- Must pass a pre-employment Drug and Alcohol test.
