The EMT-Basic level of pre-hospital emergency care. The EMT-Basic is responsible to be on call for and in the service of the White Swan Emergency Medical Ambulance Service, of the Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation. Must be certified by the Washington State and Yakima County EMS Department. Must follow the Yakama Nation Personnel Policy Manual, all Washington State and Yakima County Protocols, Policies and Procedures as well as the Policies and Procedures of the White Swan Ambulance. The EMT-Basic is one step below the EMT-Intermediate in the State of Washington for pre-hospital emergency care. This in a non-invasive field care position.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Must be capable of performance of all EMT-Basic skills, and utilization of equipment.
- Must be able to supply basic life support using a defibrillator, combitube airway for airway control in respiratory and complete arrest patients. Assess patient and determines extent of injury utilizing current diagnostic equipment. Deals with emergencies utilizing Basic Life Support equipment.
- Ability to perform CPR, non-invasive shock treatment, control bleeding, stabilization of fractures and spine, and emergency childbirth.
- Knowledge and understanding of current county protocols for the EMT-Basic.
- Ability to lift heavy patients approx. 100 pounds. Ability to make quick decisions.
- Ability to work with other agencies and communicate clearly during stressful situations.
- Current with OTEP modules and Continuing Medical Education.
- Ability to read maps correctly.
- Knowledge of Yakama Nation traditions, customs and culture.

General Recruiting Indicators:

- EMT's must be current and up to date w/continuing medical education through Yakima County ongoing training & education program for WA state certification, & will be verified through the Yakima Co. Emergency Medical Service program.

Necessary Special Requirements:

- Valid Washington State driver's license and ability to obtain a Yakama Nation driver's license.
- Must have private vehicle insurance with no restrictions.
- Valid Washington State and Yakima County EMT-Basic or IV/IV-Airway Certification.
- Must disclose any medical conditions and/or disabilities that would affect work performance, patient care and the ability to operate a vehicle safely.
- Knowledge of radio operation, technique and procedures.
- Demonstrate oral and written communication skills.
- Must be able to maintain composure under stressful conditions using mature, sound judgment in emergency situations.
- Must be knowledgeable of all Lower Valley areas, roads, homes and landmarks.
- Ability to pass a pre-employment Drug and Alcohol test.
