The employee will be responsible to maintain the overall appearance of Indian Cemeteries on the Yakama Reservation including those of cultural significance outside the reservation boundaries. Will keep in good repair the fences, gates, cemetery signs and outhouses of each cemetery and will work with the families on the maintenance of headstones.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Knowledge of Yakama tribal customs and traditions relative to funerals.
- Knowledgeable of the Yakama Reservation and location of Indian cemeteries.
- Skilled in the operation of a backhoe or the ability to gain this skill to become proficient as an equipment operator.
- Ability to perform strenuous outdoor work activities on a day-to-day basis.
- Ability to perform general maintenance and repair work that involves basic carpentry and masonry, landscaping, fence building and repairs to gates and signs.
- Ability to understand and follow oral or written instructions.
- Ability to work independently and productively.

**General Recruiting Indicators:**

- Must be physically capable of performing strenuous outdoor work activities in all types of weather conditions year round.

**Special Requirements:**

- Required to pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
- Required to pass a pre-employment background check.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver License with the ability to obtain a Tribal Permit.
