Responsible for scheduling and monitoring adherence to Mater Internal Audit Schedule by reviewing and providing constructive feedback on comprehensive audit reviews of all casino operating departments. Establishes and implements internal audit policies and procedures. Responsible for assisting in optimizing overall organizational performance by establishing cooperative and supportive working relationships with other Commission departments. Responsible for review and approval of audit findings and recommendations to finalize audit report that identifies areas of potential exposure and areas for improving operational efficiency.
